# 5. Discovery Dollars-Stacy Nivert

- A. Stacy gave an overview of Discovery Dollars and all the participating places
  - **a.** A portion of each purchased gift card/ gift certificate goes right back to Howard Gardner, while parents simply need to purchase them at face value.

- B. Last year, over \$ 4,000.00 was raised from participating families.
  - a. This money goes into Scholarship Funds for families with certain needs
  - b. It also goes towards other areas such as maintenance of the garden, etc.
  - c. Proceeds are also used to help offset the costs of various school expenses
- C. The best part is that the purchase of Discovery Dollars does not actually cost us anything. It simply changes the way we pay for items. You can enroll right on your phone.

#### 6. Volunteers

Kerri O'Boyle, speaking on Larissa Allspaugh's behalf, gave an update on:
