



Symptom Screening Tool

Howard Gardner Multiple Intelligence Charter School encourages parents/guardians, and staff, to use this screening tool to guide your decision to come to school/work. It is imperative that everyone follows this tool to ensure the safety of our school community.

Part 1: If you answer “yes” to any of the following questions, please have student/staff stay home from school/work.

1. Is the student, or staff member, taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil/Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?
2. Have you traveled to an area (state/region) with required quarantine according to Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or United States guidelines?
3. Have you/child been in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 14 days, or told by the Department of Health that you/or your student should quarantine?

Part 2:

Are you or the student experiencing any of the following symptoms?

Group A 1 or More Symptoms	Group B 2 or More Symptoms

Stay home if, you or the student:

- Have one or more symptoms in Group A OR
- Have two or more symptoms in Group B OR
- Are taking fever reducing medication OR
- Are within a window for recommended quarantine
