Dear Parents and Guardians,

On behalf of the HGMICS trustees, faculty, and staff, we extend our warmest wishes to you and your family for a healthy and happy Thanksgiving. After the Thanksgiving holiday, the School will continue to offer all-remote instruction for those who have chosen that option, and for all others, the School will operate according to the schedule detailed below and attached. You will notice that following the Thanksgiving and December holidays, an all-remote week of classes will be held as an additional precautionary measure prior to returning for in-person learning. While this schedule is our intention, circumstances may change requiring adjustments.

Nov 30-Dec 4:	Continue all-remote through December 4th
December 7 - 23:	Return to in-person learning and resume 5+ program
Holiday:	December 24, 2020, through January 3, 2021
January 4-8, 2021:	Transition back to all-remote learning
January 11, 2021:	Return to in-person learning and resume 5+ program

Additional COVID-related guidance was recently issued by Governor Wolf and the PA Departments of Health and Education. Accordingly, to reflect these changes and additional protocols that the School will put into place during this time of substantial community spread, the School's Health and Safety Plan will be updated and then posted on our website. The health and safety of your student(s), and our staff, are the highest priority.

In closing and importantly, HGMICS faculty and staff are committed to providing a positive educational experience for your students. I recently read that the K-12 educational experience during this unprecedented pandemic *should strive for progress, not perfection*.
