



### Symptom Screening Tool

Howard Gardner Multiple Intelligence School encourages parents/guardians and staff to use this screening tool to guide your decision to come to school/work. It is imperative that everyone follows this tool to ensure the safety of our school community.

**PART I:** If you answer yes to any of these questions, please have student/staff stay home from school/work.

1. Is the student or staff member taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil/Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?
2. Have you traveled outside of Pennsylvania for longer than 24 hours in the past 14 days? If so, a negative Covid test must be obtained prior to returning to school.
3. Have you/child been in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 14 days, or have been advised by the Department of Health that you/student should quarantine?

**PART II:** Are you or the student experiencing any of the following symptoms?

<b>Group A 1 or more symptoms</b>	<b>Group B 2 or more symptoms</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Fever of 100.4 or higher</li> <li>➤ Cough</li> <li>➤ Shortness of breath</li> <li>➤ Difficulty breathing</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Sore throat</li> <li>➤ Runny nose/congestion</li> <li>➤ Chills</li> <li>➤ New lack of smell or taste</li> <li>➤ Muscle pain</li> <li>➤ Nausea or vomiting</li> <li>➤ Headache</li> <li>➤ Diarrhea</li> </ul>

**Stay home if you or the student:**

- Has 1 or more symptoms in Group A OR
- Have 2 or more symptoms in Group B OR
- Are taking fever reducing medication OR
- Are within a window for recommended quarantine OR
- Have traveled outside of Pennsylvania in the past 14 days
