

Symptom Screening Tool

Howard Gardner Multiple Intelligence School encourages parents/guardians and staff to use this screening tool to guide your decision to come to school/work. It is imperative that everyone follows this tool to ensure the safety of our school community.

PART I: If you answer yes to any of these questions, please have student/staff stay home from school/work.

- 1. Is the student or staff member taking any medication to treat or reduce a fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e. Advil/Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)?
- 2. Have you traveled outside of Pennsylvania for longer than 24 hours in the past 14 days? If so, a negative Covid test must be obtained prior to returning to school.
- 3. Have you/child been in close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 14 days, or have been advised by the Department of Health that you/student should quarantine?

PART II: Are you or the student experiencing any of the following symptoms?

Stay home if you or the student:

- ➤ Has 1 or more symptoms in Group A OR
- ➤ Have 2 or more symptoms in Group B OR
- ➤ Are taking fever reducing medication OR
- Are within a window for recommended guarantine OR
- ➤ Have traveled outside of Pennsylvania in the past 14 days
