1. Authority SC 1306 Title 22 Sec 11.18 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11431 et seq

The Board recognizes its obligation to ensure that homeless students have access to educational programs and services. The Board shall make reasonable efforts to encourage their enrollment and eliminate existing barriers to their attendance and education, in compliance with federal and state law.

### 2. Definitions 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1143a

Homeless Students are defined as individuals lacking a fixed, regular and nighttime residence, which include the following conditions:

- 1. Sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing or economic hardship, or similar reason.
- 2. Living in motels, hotels, trailer parks or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations.
- 3. Living in emergency, transitional or domestic violence shelters.
- 4. Abandoned in hospitals.
- 5. Awaiting foster care placement.
- 6. Living in public, or private places not designed for or ordinarily used as regular sleeping accommodations for human beings.
- 7. Living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, transportation stations or similar settings.
- 8. Living as migratory children in conditions described in previous examples.
- 9. Living as run-away children, abandoned or forced out of homes by parents/guardians or caretakers, or separated from parents/guardians for any other reason.
- 10. Living as school age parents/guardians in houses for school age parents/guardians if they have no other living accommodations.

## 3. Delegation of Responsibility 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432

The Board designates the Executive Director or designee to serve as HGMICS's liaison for homeless students and families.

### 4. Guidelines 42 U.S.C. Sec. 11432

Students shall not be discriminated against, segregated nor stigmatized based on their status as homeless.
