Job Title: Building Substitute

Reports to: Principal

Status: Exempt; 10-month position

<u>Overview</u> Serve as a substitute teacher for needed coverage within the school's K-8 grade classes (Pods), specials, and learning support classes. When not assigned to a specific class, the Principal may assign the position to support the operations of the school and students. Works within the 180-day school year and attends pre-service, professional development, and participation in school events and activities, as scheduled.

Responsibilities

- 1. Promote the Mission and Vision of the school through daily interactions with students, colleagues, administration, and parents.
- 2. Create and maintain a nurturing, safe, and academically challenging classroom environment.
- 3. Enforce the established PBIS schoolwide expectations and classroom behavior among the students for whom you are responsible.
- 4. Apply the theory of Multiple Intelligences as identified in teacher lesson plans and classroom activities, where applicable.
- 5. Within the daily lesson plan, adapt teaching methods, instructional materials, and assessments to meet students' varying needs and interests.
- 6. When appropriate, administer, and grade tests and assignments.
- 7. Utilize instructional technology and Schoology in the classroom.
- 8. Observe and evaluate students' performance, behavior, social development, and physical health and communicate that to the regular classroom teacher.
- 9. Participate in bi-annual environmental education programming that integrates standardsaligned objectives in the natural environment.
- 10. When needed, participate in field trips to support planned activities and supervise students.
- 11. If needed, consult with the Principal and/or Director, Student Services regarding planned student interventions or IEP requirements for students within the day's assigned work schedule.
- 12. Keep abreast of current trends in elementary/middle school education.
- 13. Participate in ongoing professional development, continuing education, and necessary PDE mandatory training.
- 14. Perform other duties as assigned when not supporting in a classroom, such as but not limited to, helping with preparation of instructional materials, coverage for student discipline outcomes, back/front office support.
- 15. Comply with School policies and procedures; submit required reports/forms etc.
- 16. Attend staff meetings and serve on committees as required.

Qualifications:

- 1. High School Diploma required, Bachelor's Degree preferred
- 2. Valid Pennsylvania Teaching Certificate
- 3. Required clearances: FBI Fingerprinting, Child Abuse, and PA State Police Criminal Records
- 4. Completed those trainings required by HGMICS and the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
- 5. Ability and flexibility to educate K-8 students in diverse subject areas, student ages and changing responsibilities.
- 6. Willingness to understand and conform to the educational approach espoused in the Schools' mission and vision statements.

Compensation:

Building Substitute Salary is 75% of Teacher Salary Scale, based upon experience/education.

Should the Building Substitute be assigned to replace a teacher for more than five consecutive days, then the salary will be adjusted to the teacher scale from the first day of that specific assignment.
