Responsible for developing small group and individual mathematics interventions and supporting analysis of student progress. Maintains a cooperative attitude with staff, parents, and students.

Responsibilities

- 1. Promote the Mission and Vision of the school with students, colleagues, administration, and parents.
- 2. Create and maintain a nurturing, safe, and academically challenging learning environment.
- 3. Understands and participates in the schoolwide PBIS program.
- 4. Assist in developing, implementing, and evaluating the Schoolwide Title I program.
- 5. Utilize the theory of Multiple Intelligences in lesson planning, pedagogy, and assessment.
- 6. Coordinate and provide strategic intervention to meet the needs of schoolwide math goals.
- 7. Implement effective assessments to determine instructional needs of students in mathematics.
- 8. Provide school-wide benchmark assessment data and reports to the Federal Programs Coordinator, MTSS Committee, and teachers.
- 9. Assist teachers in developing effective mathematics instruction and assessment.
- 10. Promote high levels of achievement in relation to individual abilities.
- 11. Use techniques and methodologies appropriate to MI theory.
- 12. Demonstrate knowledge of and implementation of research-based principles of intervention.
- 13. Organize interventions using clearly defined student outcomes.
- 14. Prepare lesson plans based on state mathematics standards to address intervention needs.
- 15. Develop in-services and professional learning opportunities for staff as needed.
- 16. Plan and attend Schoolwide Title I Family Engagement activities.
- 17. Responsible for non-classroom student activities within the assigned workday.
- 18. Keep abreast of current trends in elementary/middle school mathematics education.
- 19. Participate in professional development, continuing education, and PDE mandatory training.
- 20. Comply with School policies and procedures; submit required reports/forms etc.
- 21. Attend staff meetings and serve on committees, as required.
- 22. Perform other related duties as assigned by the principal and/or CEO.
