Responsibilities

- 6. Coordinate and provide strategic and intensive reading and mathematics intervention.
- 7. Administer benchmark assessments; determine students' interventions based on results.
- 8. Report on school-wide benchmark assessment data to the Federal Programs Coordinator, MTSS Committee, and teachers.
- 9. Assist teachers in developing effective reading and mathematics instruction and assessment.
- 10. Promote high levels of achievement in relation to individual abilities.
- 11. Demonstrate knowledge of and implementation of research-based principles of intervention.
- 12. Organize interventions using clearly defined student outcomes.
- 13. Prepare Intervention Plans based on state reading and mathematics standards.
- 14. Develop and present at in-services and professional learning opportunities for staff as needed.
- 15. Plan and attend Schoolwide Title I Family Engagement activities.
- 16. Responsible for non-classroom student activities within the assigned workday.
- 17. Keep abreast of current trends in elementary/middle school intervention education.
- 18. Participate in professional development, continuing education, and PDE mandatory training.
- 19. Comply with School policies and procedures; submit required reports/forms etc.
- 20. Attend staff meetings and serve on committees, as required.
- 21. Perform other related duties as assigned by the principal and/or CEO.
